

Technical Committees Terms of Reference

- 1. Provide technical direction on each research programme to ensure programmes are well focused, of high quality and aligned with the Science and Innovation Strategy
- 2. Provide guidance to programmes as industry subject matter experts rather than as company representatives.
- 3. Develop research plans, that include key deliverable milestones, within agreed budgets and recommend to the R&D Committee for approval
- 4. Monitor and review research programme progress.
- 5. Provide guidance and make recommendations to the FOA R&D Manager on authorisation of payments for research.
- 6. Make recommendations on changes to research plans or annual programmes.
- 7. Assist with tailoring tech transfer initiatives to industry stakeholders to achieve the greatest uptake and impact.
- 8. Identification of IP that should be protected or have restricted access.
- 9. Screen proposed publications and reports for commercial sensitivity prior to release.
- 10. Act as strong advocates for the research programme and provide advice and assistance with communication to wider industry stakeholders to promote uptake of outcomes
- 11. Establish where appropriate sub groups/cluster groups to focus on specific areas of the research programme.
